

FREE POLITICAL PRISONER JEFF 'FREE' LUERS



How to help support Jeff 'Free' Luers

1. You can contribute funds to Jeff's appeal or to his commissary account a few different ways:

- You can send checks/money orders made out to "Free's Defense Fund" to POB 3, Eugene, OR 97440.
- Donations can be made online on a secure server through Paypal. To make a donation, go to www.freefreenow.org and click the 'make a donation' button on the homepage. All names/addresses are kept confidential. These donations go to fund Jeff's appeals.
- You can contribute directly to Jeff's commissary account: These funds are used by Jeff to buy necessities like pens, stamps, envelopes etc. Money orders only [no checks] can be made out to: DOC Central Trust for (For Jeffrey Luers, #13797671) and sent to DOC Central Trust for (For Jeffrey Luers, #13797671). 2. **Media attention:** Jeff's case desperately needs to stay in the news and in the public's mind in order to affect his appeal and chances of getting out. Letters to Oregon based media are very useful. Here are a few media outlets you can write to.

3. Form a support group/work directly with Jeff

4. Distribute Jeff's new zine, *Heartcheck*
